Beginning January 2014, changes were made to the internship program as follows:

- Minimum GPA to earn internship credits was increased from 2.0 to 2.5
- Students were required to successfully complete a minimum of 12 credits (in major) before applying to earn internship credits.
- Students were required to complete an on-line Internship Application Form to be eligible to earn internship credits.
- Internship Workshops were conducted to enhance students' awareness of the internship program (including the knowledge that internship credits could not be used to take the place of elective general education courses required by their program major).
- Intentional networking was done with Industry Advisory Council Members to provide more Internship opportunities for students.

Outcomes:

- More students participate in internship experiences (increasing employability upon graduation) - 95% increase from 2012 - 2015.
- Less students apply to earn credits for the internship (as they are not required for graduation) - 23% decrease from 2012 - 2015.
