Faculty work load includes a teaching load of 15 contact hours per week, holding 10 office/advising hours per week, and participating in college professional activities. Minimum requirements include a Master's degree in Mathematics or Math Education. The candidate must have a minimum of three current years of teaching experience, demonstrated understanding of pedagogy.

Preferred requirements include a doctorate in Mathematics or Education, five or more years of teaching experience, demonstrated success as a team member, and experience working with diverse populations, under-resourced groups, and first-generational students.

Salary and rank for the position is determined on the basis of academic preparation and experience as projected on the Faculty Association contract.
