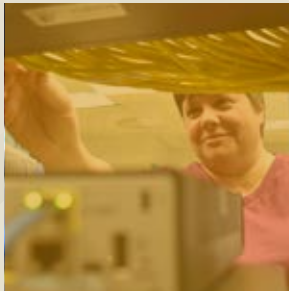

You will have the chance to speak with your future professors and instructors on what to expect in any of TSCT's 23 majors, plus hear what a career in these industries are like directly from industry representatives looking to hire our graduates. You'll be able to chart a clear path from college to your future!

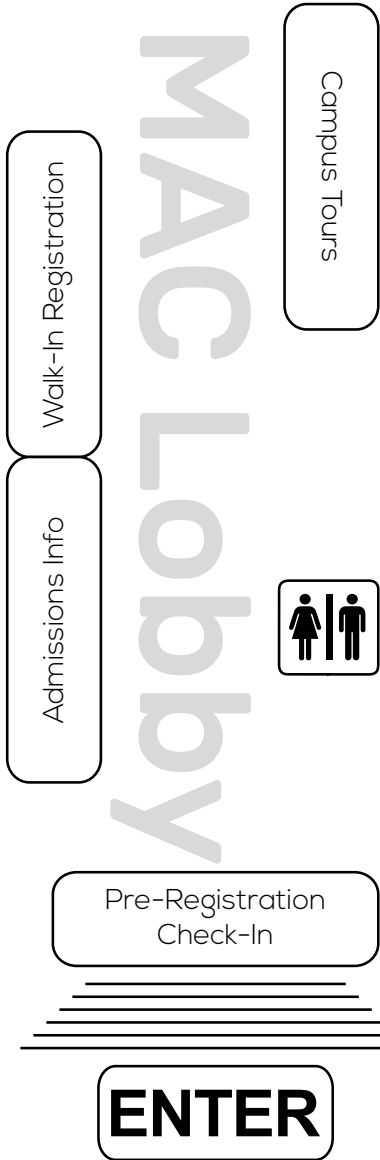
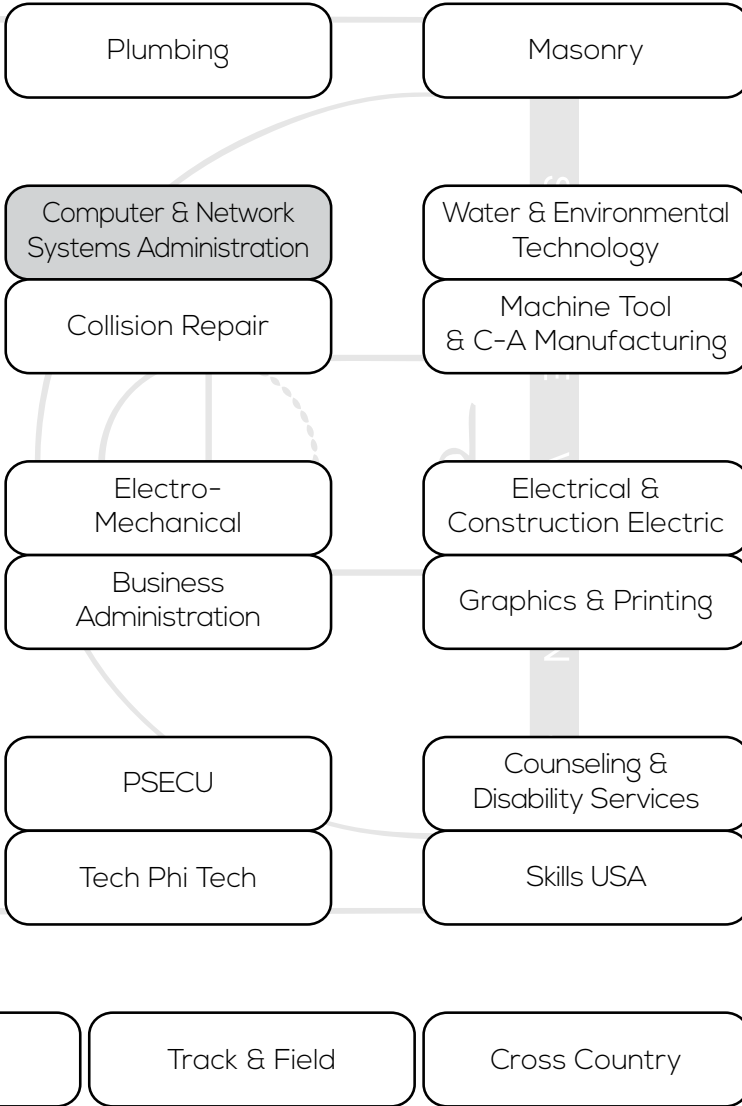

## Make your visit count

### Residence Halls—10:30 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Three residence halls will be open for visits. Drop in during **Open Campus** or during a guided **Campus Tour**, which will end at the residence halls. Open dorm rooms on Main Campus are **Herrington 103** and **109** for men (#8 on map) and **Brenner 101** for women (#7 on map). Rooms **C-188** (women) and **E-365** (men) will also be open for visitors to Thaddeus Stevens on Orange. (About half of all residential students are housed at the Orange Street location.)

### Shuttle Service—10 a.m. to 1 p.m.
