Beginning January 2014, changes were made to the internship program as follows:

- Minimum GPA to earn internship credits was increased from 2.0 to 2.5
- Students were required to successfully complete a minimum of 12 credits (in major) before applying to earn internship credits.
- Students were required to complete an on-line Internship Application Form to be eligible to earn internship credits.
- Internship Workshops were conducted to enhance students' awareness
 of the internship program (including the knowledge that internship
 credits could not be used to take the place of elective general
- Intentional networking was done with Industry Advisory Council Members to provide more Internship opportunities for students.
- Hourly rate of on-campus internships was increased from \$10.00 to \$15.00 summer 2018

Outcomes:

- More students participate in internship experiences (increasing employability upon graduation)
- 95% increase from 2012 2015.
- Less students apply to earn credits for the internship (as they are not required for graduation nor embedded in curriculum) 23% decrease from 2012 2015.
- More students participate in internship experiences (increasing employability upon graduation)
- 95% increase from 2012 2015.
- Fun Fact: 97% of students from the class of 2017 who interned during college, had full-time job offers prior to graduation.
